Phonics Screening Check – Year 1

This week, our Year 1 pupils have been completing the national **Phonics Screening Check**. This short, school-based assessment helps us understand each child's progress in reading and word decoding. We are delighted to report that the children approached the assessment with great enthusiasm and focus – they all did fantastically well, and we are incredibly proud of their efforts.

Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

Our Year 4 pupils are currently undertaking the **Multiplication Tables Check (MTC)** – an online assessment designed to evaluate fluency in times tables up to 12×12 . The check is a useful tool for identifying areas where children may need additional support in mathematics. We are pleased with the hard work and commitment the children have shown, and we are confident they will perform extremely well.

A big thank you to all parents who attended today's **Reading Coffee Morning**. We hope you found the session informative and engaging.

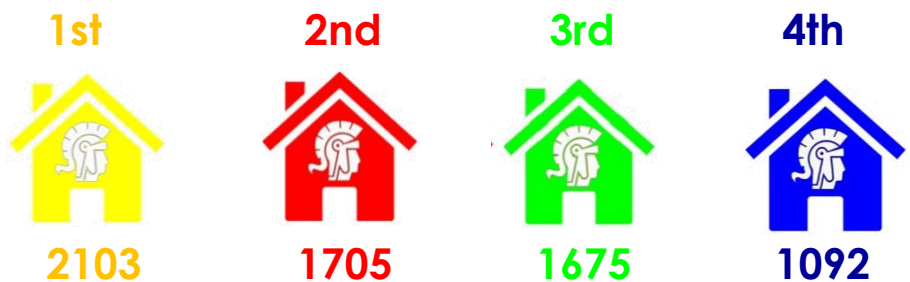

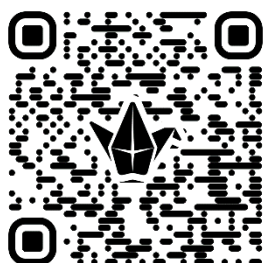

If we are unable to get the man power behind us, we will have no choice but to cancel. Are you able to help? Any help big or small will be appreciated.

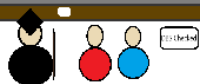

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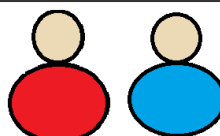
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
